The 2019 Arizona Horseman's Challenge & Expo will offer more than 50 clinics over three days. This epic event will be held at Horseshoe Park & Equestrian Centre in Queen Creek April 19-21. This facility has four arenas, a round pen clinic area as well as a seated clinic area. There will be clinics held all day long, in five different areas each of the three days, as well as a Working Equitation Horse Show and obstacle clinic.

The Arizona Horseman's Challenge is a colt starting competition. This event has five trainers working with untrained BLM mustangs from the Florence holding facility in five round pens at the same time. The goal of this competition is to put the best foundation they can on these horses, in 8 hours, over three days. This is an unparalleled opportunity to watch five trainers working side by side in a competition. The first session of training starts Friday evening, from 6-8pm, with two more sessions happening Saturday morning and afternoon, then one more Sunday morning, followed by the finale on Sunday at 1pm.
